April 20, 2009 – Dinner at Graziano’s. FUND69 will receive 25% of your bill (food and beverages) for both dine in or take-out.

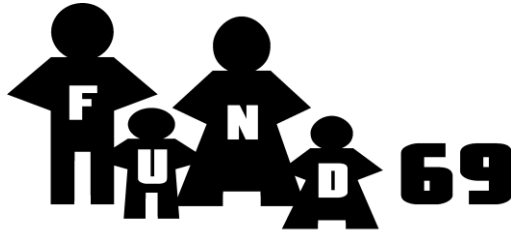
May 20, 2009 – Dinner at Village Inn. FUND69 will receive 20% of your bill for both dine in and take out.
